Week 2025 as part of its commitment to

promoting financial literacy

The Financial Market Council is taking part, for the sixth consecutive year, in the

activities of the "World Investor Week 2025", an international initiative

organized under the auspices of the International Organization of Securities

Commissions (IOSCO), which brings together the majority of financial market

regulatory authorities around the world.

This global event gathers a large number of regulatory authorities and financial

institutions from various continents, reflecting the growing international interest

in this global campaign aimed at strengthening financial education and investor

protection.

In this context, the Financial Market Council will organize its national activities

for the World Investor Week from 20 to 24 October 2025, under a theme focused

on technology, digital finance, and the prevention of fraud and market

manipulation.

The planned activities will include the publication of digital educational content

related to the main themes of the 2025 edition, with an international dimension

highlighting the fruitful cooperation between the Financial Market Council and

blockchain technology, and the second to securitization mechanisms.

In addition, the Financial Market Council will publish the "Smart Investor Guide",

developed within the framework of its cooperation with the Union of Arab

Securities Authorities (UASA), in support of ongoing efforts to raise awareness

and protect investors.

Complementing these initiatives, the Financial Market Council will also organize

a series of outreach activities for students from Tunisian universities and higher

education institutions, aimed at presenting in detail its missions, and the various

components of the Tunisian financial market.
